

Evidence Based District Achievement and Collaboration Goal

“80% staff participation in two community service activities of their choosing within the Germantown School District community for the 2015-16 fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2015.”



The goal is one of helping others in the Germantown School District community through volunteerism

- Activity benefits the communities of the Germantown School District.
- Proceeds or services need to benefit a community non-profit organizations.
- Volunteering may be, but not limited to, planning, preparing, implementing and active participation in an event. A monetary donation, or paying a registration fee alone does not qualify as an approved activity, nor does attendance as a spectator.
- Volunteering as a coach of a team or club leader, that is a direct result of your own child or family member's involvement would be considered one “community service” activity.
- Activity involves participation and involvement that extends beyond the Germantown School District staff paid time and the student's school day.
- If activity is part of a student group of which one is an advisor, volunteering should be an activity that extends beyond the usual and past activities completed as a paid advisor.

Evidence Based District Achievement and Collaboration Goal

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The goal is one of helping others in the Germantown School District community through volunteerism (cont.)

- Be an activity where recognition as a group or an employee of the Germantown School District can be publicized.
- Participation must be verified via artifact.
- Approval requests and artifacts need to be submitted by each individual with approval letter attached, even if a group event.
- Letters of recommendation for Germantown High School students will count as one activity for one time only. A minimum of three letters is required for this event to count.
- Activities or fund-raisers that support your own school, i.e., PTA events, Fall Festivals, etc. can only count one time only. Your second activity needs to be for an organization other than your own school.
- Volunteering at another school, other than where you are employed, will count as an approvable event.
- If you are in doubt as to an activity meeting any of these guidelines, please do not hesitate to confer with Jon Stachowiak (GHS), Tom Wilcox (KMS), Melissa Pecunia (Mac), or Cynthia Coley.

Process

- Complete a Pre-approval Google form; Staff Website, Staff Use Tab “*GSD Volunteer Goal Approval Form*”
- Your Google account password is the same as your Novell password
- Information that will be collected for each volunteer activity includes:
 - Type of voluntary activity/event (organizing fund raiser for a non-profit organization, volunteering for a non-profit cause, Adopt-a-Highway, reading at story hour at Public Library),
 - Name of benefit/cause: (local, county, state, national),
 - Identification of communities benefitting,
 - Date(s), time(s) and location of the event,
 - Participation –GSD Group or Individual
 - Upon completion, documentation that will be provided to verify participation
- Submit the form via button on the end of the form
- You will receive approval/non-approval notice via e-mail
- Upon completion, you will need to attach the approval form to your documentation/artifact and scan or send both via interoffice mail to Cynthia
- Record of your completed activity will be documented in your personal employee Skyward account. (*User Defined Fields – Volunteer Activity*)
