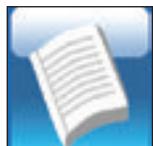

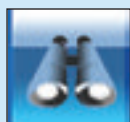
Features a new Dual-Page View option



Switch to Dual-Page View: This icon is displayed when the eBook is in Single-Page view mode. Click it to switch to Dual-Page view mode.



Switch to Single-Page View: This icon is displayed when the eBook is in Dual-Page view mode. Click it to switch to Single-Page view mode.



Find: Searches for the first instance of a word in the eBook, and highlights every instance of the word on the page.



Find Next Occurrence: Switches the page view to the next page the word is found, and again highlights all instances on the page. Each click moves to the next page the word is found.



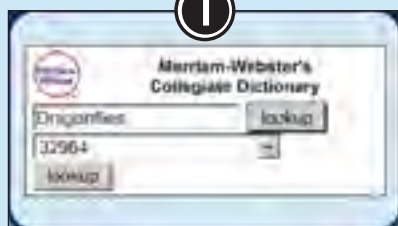
Go To Page: Navigates to a specific page in the eBook.



Open Dictionary: Pops up a dictionary search window to the left of the eBook to allow readers to search Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary two ways:

1. Type in any word, even words not in the current eBook.
2. Use the alphabetical pull-down list to look-up any word on the eBook page (except for conjunctions and articles).

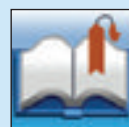
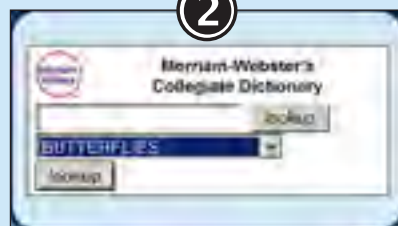


Table of Contents: Displays the eBook's table of contents on the left-hand side of the window. If the button is grayed out, the publisher did not provide a Table of Contents for the eBook.



Download: Checks out and downloads a copy of the eBook for viewing with the Follett Digital Reader – Offline. If the button is grayed out, your school does not allow the eBook to be downloaded.



Return Book: Closes the eBook window and checks it back in to make it available to other patrons.



Zoom Out: Decreases the size of the page.



Default Zoom Level: Displays the page at 100%.



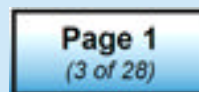
Zoom In: Enlarges the size of the page.



Go To First Page: Switches the view to the the front cover or first page of the eBook.



Go to Previous Page: Switches the view to the preceding page in the eBook.



Page Number: Displays the current page number as specified by the publisher, as well as the page number relative to the total number of pages in the book.



Go to Next Page: Switches the view to the next page in the eBook.



Go To Last Page: Switches the view to the back cover or last page of the eBook.
