

# KMS PTA MINUTES

## DECEMBER 14<sup>TH</sup>, 2010

1. Call to order: The meeting was called to order by Colleen Thompson at 7:00 p.m.
2. Welcome: Colleen welcomed everyone and introductions were made.
3. Agenda Additions: 1. Drug Education
4. Approval of Minutes: A motion to approve the November, 2010 Minutes as written was made by Tammi Valenti and seconded by Anne Proite. Motion was carried.

  - d. Reflections: The theme is "Together We Can". Amy Belle is not able to host the event this year. Rockfield School is not doing a local show. All the entries will be sent to the State level, but not the local level.
  - e. Bake Sale: The bake sale went well. PTA made a \$543 profit.
8. Old Business:
  - a. Fundraiser Ideas: 1. Recycle fundraiser set for May 21, 2011. 2. Check into hosting concessions for DI at KMS. 3. Mr. Z's pizza.
  - b. Shopping Fundraiser: Patty Johnson (via email) reports the web portal is up. Monthly reminders will be sent out. There are 3500 different stores participating with a

percentage going to KMS. A link will be offered on the main page of the KMS website. Currently, 16 people have signed up as preferred customers with only one person making a purchase. We will evaluate in January to see if this was successful.

9. New Business:

a. Drug education: Kris Murray reports the grants came through. \$500 came from Kiwanis and Youth Futures. \$500 came from Community Memorial Hospital. Kris Murray asked to send an additional \$500 to “Your Choice” to make our contribution a total of \$2000. A motion was made to send \$500 to “Your Choice” by Anne Proite and seconded by Patti Chapman. We voted, and the motion carried.
