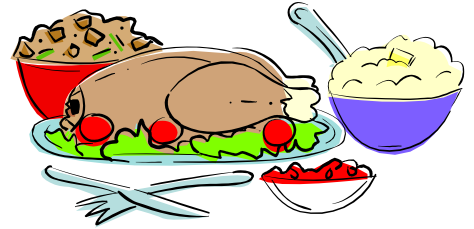


Let's STUFF That Bus!
