- **Attention Juniors:** The Preliminary SAT (PSAT) will be given at GHS on Wednesday, October 11th during hours 1-3. The PSAT is recommended for 11th grade students who are ranked in the top 50% of their class (Cumulative GPA of 3.1 or higher) and typically plan on attending a four-year college. This test serves as the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (NMSQT). The PSAT/NMSQT will be open to the first 90 11th graders who register. The

NMSQT competition is only open to 11th graders. Registration will stay open as long as tests remain available through October 11th. Please contact your school counselor with any questions. Cost for the PSAT will be \$16. Bring a check made out to GHS to the School Counseling Office to secure your spot ASAP.
