### **1) Fleet Reserve Association – Essay Contest**

Open to all high school students. Essay must answer the question “What Does Memorial Day Mean to Me” in 350 words or less. Prize money ranges from \$50-\$100. Application materials can be found in the Guidance Office.

### **6) Voice of Democracy**

Open to all students. Applicants compete by writing and recording a broadcast script on an annual patriotic theme. This year's theme is *Does America Still Have Heroes?* Prizes and scholarships are awarded at the local, district, state, and national level. Scholarships range from \$100 for 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the local level to \$30,000 for 1<sup>st</sup> place at the national level. See Ms. Hernandez in Guidance if you would like to participate. Entries should be returned to the guidance office by the deadline.

**7) Americanism and Government Test Program**

Open to sophomores, juniors, and seniors. This program tests students' knowledge of current events, county, Wisconsin and US government and history, and the US flag. It consists of fifty questions and one short essay. The two highest scores of from each grade will be forwarded to the district level. Scholarships are available to winners at higher levels of competition.

Application Deadline: Please see Mrs. Hernandez in Guidance by October 22, 2009 if you are interested in participating. Testing will take place between November 2-6, 2009.

**8) American Legion Oratorical Contest**

The Oratorical Contest is designed to encourage students to increase their knowledge of the US Constitution, examine their individual roles as citizens, and develop abilities in public speaking. Students deliver an eight to ten minute prepared oration on some aspect of the Constitution with emphasis on the duties and obligations of a citizen to our government. Participants are also assigned a topic pertaining to the US Constitution the night of the contest and expected to deliver a second oration between three and five minutes in length. Participation is open to any student. Awards range from \$600 at the regional level to \$18,000 at the national level.
