



**SPECIAL NOTE: VISITOR MANAGEMENT/IDENTITY
VERIFICATION SYSTEM (RAPTOR)**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please know, that for enhanced safety and security for your children and our staff, we have added RAPTOR to our visitor management/control protocol and processes beginning with the 2018-19 school year. We want to make you aware that if you or someone else is visiting a school campus during the school day or other selected events, **A GOVERNMENT ISSUED PICTURE ID WILL BE REQUIRED FOR YOUR FIRST VISIT** – the system only stores name, date of birth, and the last four digits of the ID presented. Raptor scans the sex offender data base of all 50 states and, upon clearance, then prints a “time-sensitive” visitor badge that allows for your controlled access in the building beyond the front desk – if you are only dropping off or picking up items at the front desk, the use of Raptor is not necessary AND, once in the system, you do not need to produce the ID for future visits. We greatly appreciate your patience and understanding as we look to better ensure safety and security throughout the District.
