1. Students **MUST** display the parking permit on their rear-view mirror, indicating school permission to park on school grounds. Any vehicle not registered or without a properly displayed permit may be ticketed at the owner's expense. Continued failure to not display parking permit may result in revocation of parking privileges. The parking fee WILL NOT be refunded if revoked.
2. Drivers must observe the posted speed limit, drive safely and observe all other applicable driving regulations and parking restrictions, including safety barriers. Any inappropriate or unsafe driving behaviors may result in ticketing and/or revocation of parking privileges. The parking fee WILL NOT be refunded if parking privileges are revoked.
3. Student's vehicle must be parked in their individually designated spot only. Students who choose to park their vehicle in a lot other than their own, without Administrative approval, will be warned once and then ticketed. Parking privileges may be REVOKED. The parking fee WILL NOT be refunded if parking privileges are revoked.
4. Vehicles are to be locked and are not to be used for any other purpose during the school day without Administrative approval. Students are not to loiter in the parking lots at any time.
5. **STUDENTS MAY NOT SELL OR GIVE THEIR PARKING PERMIT TO ANYONE ELSE.** Doing so may result in the revocation of parking privileges. The parking fee WILL NOT be refunded if the parking permit is revoked.
6. Student vehicles may be subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion of illegal items or activity.
7. Students will be subject to disciplinary action, which can include the loss of parking privileges, **if it is found that students are leaving campus without Administrative approval and/or have attendance/tardy issues.** Repeated unexcused tardies and/or absences may lead to suspension of parking privileges.
8. It shall be understood that the undersigned releases the Germantown School District and its employees from any claims for responsibility or liability arising from the student's driving or damages to the student's vehicle.

I have read the above stated school policies concerning parking permits and understand that parking is a privilege and not a right. I will assist school officials with the enforcement of the above policies.

SENIOR & JUNIOR STUDENT PARKING PERMIT PRIVILEGE REQUEST FORM

Parking at Germantown High School is a privilege. It is greatly sought after by a large number of students and does not match the number of parking spots available. Unfortunately, we are not able to accommodate everyone who wishes to have a vehicle here at school. Any student not receiving a parking spot will be placed on a wait list.

The assigning of parking spots will occur in the following manner:

1. GHS enrolled and licensed **2018-19 Seniors** with forms turned in by the SENIOR deadline of Friday, April 27, 2018. Payment can be remitted at this time, but will not be cashed/posted until June.
2. Lottery system for the remaining available parking spots for GHS enrolled and licensed **2018-19 Juniors** (and Seniors not meeting the 4/27/18 deadline) with forms turned in by the Friday, May 4, 2018 deadline. Must have driver's license obtained by August 31, 2018 in order to get a parking spot. DO NOT remit payment at this time. Wait until you are notified that you received a lottery parking spot.

NOTE: All outstanding student fees (school and co-curricular) must be paid before the student will be considered for a parking permit.

Should your student receive a parking spot for the 2018-19 school year, the **\$200 fee** (payable to Germantown High School) must be received by **Friday, June 1, 2018**. Any student who does not remit payment by the deadline or has outstanding school and/or co-curricular fees will be placed on the waiting list.

The privilege of parking on school grounds may be revoked should a student encounter attendance problems or discipline issues. The parking fee WILL NOT be refunded if a student's parking privileges are revoked.

We understand the difficulties families and students go through when a student wants to drive and there are no student parking spots available. We, at Germantown High School, are indeed sensitive to those needs and concerns. We are doing all we can to provide the best parking system to meet the needs of the greatest number of GHS students.
